Batter Up Baseball!

Activities for Addition Fact Fluency

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Dear Parents,

We have introduced our "Batter Up Math" program in our class. Your child is given a math fact quiz, focusing on a specific addend such as +0, +1, +2, etc. They are given about 1 minute to complete their quiz. They earn sticker baseballs each time they successfully complete their math fact quiz for their Score Board Children who do not pass their quiz, will retake the same quiz until the facts are completed successfully. Should your child have difficulty after taking a quiz, it is strongly suggested that they spend some time reviewing addition flashcards at home.

Each child is working at their own level and pace.

It cannot be stressed enough the importance of having "Fact Power" and memorizing the math addition facts! Using flash cards at home is a great way to commit those facts to memory. Please continue to encourage your child and ask for updates on how they are doing on Batter Up Math!

BATTER UP FLASH CARDS

Copy each set of Flash Cards on colored construction paper. You may choose to pass them out when a student reaches a level (before they take the test) or after they don't pass it for the first time. Students look forward to getting to the next "color" flash cards.

Batter Up Tests

There are 2 tests per page (A and B). Copy each page and cut down the middle. They are basically both the same, just the order is different. We like to give the student the opposite test if they need to retake it. Once a student successfully passes a test, they move on to the next one.
