### Forest Bingo

1. Acorn: a small, oval-shaped nut in a cup-shaped base that grows on oak trees

2. Burrow: a hole or tunnel dug by a small animal to live in

3. Conifer: a tree that stays green all year, needle-shaped leaves

4. Deciduous: plants who lose their leaves during the seasons

5. Den: a wild animal's home

6. Earthworm: a long, thin, worm-like animal that lives in the soil

7. Leaf: a flat, green part of a plant that grows from a stem

8. Moss: a small, green, plant-like organism that grows in damp places

9. Mushroom: a fungus that grows on the ground or on decaying matter

10. Night: the time of day when the sun is not visible

11. Pinecone: a woody, cone-shaped structure that grows on pine trees

12. Nocturnal: animals that are active at night

13. Pine: a type of coniferous tree

14. Stream: a small body of water that flows in a channel

15. Leaf litter: dead leaves and other organic matter that has fallen to the ground

### Forest Art Project

**Materials**

Background	1 Blue Rectangle 9" x 12"
Forest Floor	1 Brown Rectangle 4" x 9"
Trees	1 Green Rectangle 3" x 6"
-Tree Trunk	1 Dark Brown Rectangle 1" x 4"
-Body/Tail	1 Light Brown Rectangle 3" x 9"
-Head	2" x 3"
Ears	1 Light Brown Rectangle 1" x 2"
Arms/Feet	1 Light Brown Rectangle 3/4" x 6"
Belly/Cheeks	1 Dark Brown Rectangle 2" x 5"
Eyes	1 White Rectangle 1/4" x 2"

**Directions**

1. **Forest Floor:** Place large blue paper on desk in vertical position. Hold brown rectangle in vertical position and tear along an edge to create a jagged side. Glue smooth side to the bottom of the paper.
2. **Trees:** Fold green rectangle in half. Cut in half diagonally. Open and cut on left side (there should be 4 triangles). Place tree trunk on left side of page and layer triangles on top of the trunk, overlapping slightly at tops.
3. **Squirrel Body:** Fold 3" x 9" rectangle in half. Open and cut the fold. Place one rectangle aside. Round all 4 corners of rectangle to make an oval.
4. **Squirrel Tail:** Take other rectangle and make zigzag cuts up both of the sides, close to the edges. Round the top. Glue tail on back of body towards the bottom. Angle the tail up and to the side.
