**Ocean Art Project**

Materials:

- 1 Background Paper
- 1 Blue Paper
- 1 Brown Paper
- 1 Green Paper
- 1 Yellow Paper
- 1 Red Paper
- 1 Black Paper
- 1 White Paper
- 1 Blue Ribbon
- 1 Curving Ribbon
- 1 Scissors
- 1 Glue
- 1 Black Marker
- 1 Crayon
- 1 Seaweed

Directions:

- Sand:** Position the paper vertically. Fold the top corners in to the center. Cut along the fold to create a wavy edge. Glue the sand to the back of the paper.
- Seaweed:** Cut a strip of paper for the seaweed. Fold it in half. Cut it into a wavy shape. Glue the seaweed to the back of the paper.
- Fish:** This one's a little tricky! Hold a rectangle in vertical position. Fold from top to bottom. Cut the corners to create a fish shape. Glue the fish to the back of the paper.
- Coral:** This one's a little tricky! Hold a rectangle in vertical position. Fold from top to bottom. Cut the corners to create a coral shape. Glue the coral to the back of the paper.
- Scrap:** Use extra scraps to create a small fish, a small sea animal, and seaweed.

Use a black pen or crayon to add eyes to your ocean animals.
