The Polar Habitat

3. Penguin:

Body: Fold the large black rectangle in 3 vertical sections. Cut off the top two corners and stand to the head of the penguin.

Apply: Fold the white rectangle in 2 vertical sections. Cut off the top corners and stand to the back of the penguin.

Arms: Fold the skin black rectangle in a vertical section. Fold it in half and fold the left side in to the back corners of the body. Give the arms out on the sides and give the wings a flap.


Feet and Beak: Cut the orange legs on a diagonal. Fold the orange beak in the bottom of the white reinforcement. Give the beak a flap on the top side.

Eyes: Attach two reinforcement circle labels above the orange beak for the eyes.

4. Icebergs:

Arrange icebergs in the water with the orange in the bottom. Place string in the top of one of the icebergs.

Give it a place.
