Savanna Definitions

- Acacia Tree: The tree has umbrella-shaped trees that enable it to capture rain during the season. The leaves are used to keep the animals cool.
- Baobab: These trees store water in its giant trunk when it rains. The water is used to capture water when there is no rain.
- Carnivore: An animal that eats other animals.
- Cheetah: A fast animal that lives in the savanna.
- Herbivore: An animal that eats plants.
